

## NGC Exposure Sites Submission Process

After extensive consultation with members of the Trust Advisory Committee (the “TAC”), the Legal Representative, firms that established Common Exposure Locations (“CELs”) and other firms filing claims with the Trust, the Trustees have decided to make available a list of all known NGC exposure sites. These sites are the result of submissions by various law firms in accordance with the Trust’s procedures for establishing a CEL and additional sites known to the Trust based on allowed property damage claims.

Firms may add new sites to the NGC Exposure Sites list by using the following procedure:

- Submit the proposed site exposure documentation to the Trust for review.
- Such documents must clearly identify the NGC asbestos containing material (product name or type) installed at the site and establish an initial exposure date.
- Examples of such documentation include (i) deposition testimony, (ii) affidavit testimony, (iii) verified work histories, (iv) advertisements and (v) other documents such as correspondence from NGC or records of product complaints filed with NGC.
- The Trust will review the submitted documentation and will notify the submitting firm once the new NGC Exposure Site has been approved or if additional supporting documentation is needed.
- Newly approved sites will be added to the NGC Exposure Sites list posted on the Trust website under the “Reports” tab. The list will be updated weekly.

The NGC Exposure Sites Lists is available under the “Reports” tab with the appropriate user login.
