

EXHIBIT 1

Minimum Exposure Requirements NGC Bodily Injury Trust

These Minimum Exposure Requirements are to be used as a guide for how to provide the information required to satisfy the Restated Exposure Policies. The content of the affidavit varies depending on 1) the Affiant's knowledge of the installation of the NGC asbestos-containing material ("ACM"); 2) the exposure of the Injured Party to the NGC ACM; 3) the friability of the NGC ACM; and 4) the Injured Party's disease. Please refer to the Restated Exposure Policies document (as revised November 18, 2013) for more detail.

A. Affidavit Establishing Installation of NGC ACM at a Specific Jobsite:

Applicability: Affiant (Injured Party, co-worker or other third party, as the case may be, testifying to installation of NGC ACM).

Applicable Form Affidavit: **Installer**

1. Notarized with jurat or signed "Under Penalty of Perjury"
2. Affirms:
 - a. [Only for Non-Meso affidavits where the Installer is the Injured Party.] Specify the years, occupation, industry, city and state of exposure to any asbestos or asbestos-containing products.
 - b. Specify each location(s) of installation of the NGC ACM – jobsite with city/state, industry, name of building(s) and, if applicable, area(s) in building(s) where the NGC ACM was installed.
 - c. Specify the year(s) and duration of installation of the NGC ACM (installation must fall within the specific product or product type manufacture dates).
 - d. Specify the Affiant's occupation while installing the NGC ACM
 - e. Specify the installed NGC ACM by product name or product type
 - f. Describe in detail how the Affiant knew the installed ACM product or product type was NGC.

B. Affidavit of Injured Party Establishing Exposure During Installation of NGC ACM:

Applicability: Injured Party testifying to his/her own exposure during the installation of NGC ACM (Installation of the NGC ACM must, in most instances, be established through an Installer affidavit or an approved Common Exposure Location ("CEL").

Applicable Form Affidavit: **Exposure During Installation**

1. Notarized with jurat or signed "Under Penalty of Perjury"
2. Affirms:
 - a. [Only for Non-Meso affidavits.] Specify the years, occupation, industry, city and state of exposure to any asbestos or asbestos-containing products.
 - b. Specify each location(s) of exposure during the installation of the NGC ACM – jobsite with city/state, industry, name of building(s) and, if applicable, area(s) in building(s) where the exposure occurred.
 - c. Specify the year(s) and duration of exposure during installation of the NGC ACM (exposure during the installation of the NGC ACM must fall within the specific product or product type manufacture dates).
 - d. Specify the Injured Party's occupation while he/she was exposed during the installation of the NGC ACM.
 - e. If known, specify the installed NGC ACM by product name or product type.
 - f. Describe in detail how the Injured Party came to believe the installed ACM was NGC.
 - g. Describe in detail how the Injured Party was exposed to the NGC ACM during installation.

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C. Affidavit of Injured Party Establishing Exposure Post-Installation of Non-Friable NGC ACM:

Applicability: Injured Party testifying to his/her own exposure through 1981 during removal, rip-out or other disturbance to previously installed NGC ACM during its friable state (Installation of the Non-Friable NGC ACM must be established through an Installer affidavit or an approved Common Exposure Location ("CEL").

Applicable Form Affidavit: **Exposure Post-Installation Non-Friable NGC ACM**

1. Notarized with jurat or signed "Under Penalty of Perjury"
2. Affirms:
 - a. [Only for Non-Meso affidavits.] Specify the years, occupation, industry, city and state of exposure to asbestos or asbestos-containing products.
 - b. Specify each location(s) of exposure through removal, rip-out or other disturbance of the previously installed Non-Friable NGC ACM during its friable state – jobsite with city/state, industry, name of building(s) and, if applicable, area(s) in building(s) where the exposure occurred.
 - c. Specify the year(s) and duration of exposure through removal, rip-out or other disturbance to the previously installed Non-Friable NGC ACM during its friable state.
 - d. Specify the Injured Party's occupation while he/she was exposed through removal, rip-out or other disturbance to the previously installed Non-Friable NGC ACM during its friable state.
 - e. If known, specify the Non-Friable NGC ACM by product name or product type that was removed, ripped-out or otherwise disturbed after it was installed.
 - f. Describe in detail how the Injured Party came to believe the previously installed Non-Friable ACM was NGC.
 - g. Describe in detail how the Injured Party was exposed through removal, rip-out or other disturbance to the previously installed Non-Friable NGC ACM during its friable state.

D. Affidavit of Injured Party Establishing Exposure Post-Installation of Friable NGC ACM:

Applicability: Injured Party testifying to his/her own exposure through 1981 to Friable NGC ACM after it was installed (Installation of the Friable NGC ACM must be established through an Installer affidavit or an approved Common Exposure Location ("CEL").

Applicable Form Affidavit: **Exposure Post-Installation Friable NGC ACM**

1. Notarized with jurat or signed "Under Penalty of Perjury"
2. Affirms:
 - a. [Only for Non-Meso affidavits.] Specify the years, occupation, industry, city and state of exposure to asbestos or asbestos-containing products.
 - b. Specify each location(s) of exposure to previously installed Friable NGC ACM – jobsite with city/state, industry, name of building(s) and, if applicable, area(s) in building(s) where the exposure occurred.
 - c. Specify the year(s) and duration of exposure to the previously installed Friable NGC ACM.
 - d. Specify the Injured Party's occupation while he/she was exposed to the previously installed Friable NGC ACM.
 - e. If known, specify the Friable NGC ACM by product name or product type that was previously installed.
 - f. Describe in detail how the Injured Party came to believe the previously installed Friable ACM was NGC.
 - g. Describe in detail how the Injured Party was exposed to the previously installed Friable NGC ACM.

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- E. Affidavit of **Third Party** Establishing Exposure for the Injured Party (not for use in establishing CEL):
Applicability: Third Party testifying to Injured Party's actual NGC ACM exposure or testifying to the Injured Party's presence at an established CEL.
Applicable Form Affidavits: **Exposure During Installation or Exposure Post-Installation**
1. Notarized with jurat or signed "Under Penalty of Perjury"
 2. Affirms:
As applicable, same requirements as in B.2., C.2. or D.2. above, depending upon the exposure of the Injured Party.
 3. Must state basis for knowledge of how the Third Party (Affiant) is able to affirm the required exposure information. If the Affiant is a family member, the Affiant may certify that his or her knowledge is a result of the familial relationship and explain the relationship. When there is no familial relationship, the source of and support for such certified knowledge must be clearly stated by the Affiant.
